2. Temporary Service

A temporary electric service is defined as supplying a site with electrical power for **ONE YEAR OR LESS**. The most common use of a temporary service is to supply power to a construction site until provisions are made on a permanent structure for an electrical service. If permanent provisions are not provided within one year, HREMC will return to disconnect service. **Temporary services are to be located outside of the reserved work area.**



Available Services

This section will cover 120/240V requirements for temporary service. If a higher voltage temporary service is required, please contact the systems engineer to discuss your requirements.

2.1 Temporary Overhead Services

It is the members/contractors responsibility to install their equipment per applicable NEC standards. Refer to Fig 2.1 for Temporary Overhead Service requirement



2.2 Temporary Underground Services

It is the members/contractors responsibility to install their equipment per applicable NEC standards. Refer to Fig 2.2 for Temporary Overhead Service requirements.
